From Last Sunday's Business Meeting

At the August 20 business meeting, the church approved the following two projects on the recommendation of the Properties Committee:

- A contract with Karr Tuckpointing for \$169,000 to repair the outside bricks and mortar on the church's buildings. Work is expected to begin in the Fall of 2018.
- A contract with Oncor as part of their "Take a Load Off" initiative to replace all light fixtures in the church with LED lighting at a discounted cost of \$22,700. Work is expected to be done this fall. The payback in lower lighting and HVAC costs is expected to be 1-2 years.
