HOW TO BECOME A CHRISTIAN

God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life — abundant and eternal. Because of our nature, we are separated from God. We have all chosen to disobey God and go our own way. (Romans 3:23)

Jesus Christ is the only answer to this problem. He died on the cross and rose from the grave. In this way, Jesus bridges the gap between God and people. We must trust Jesus Christ and receive Him into our hearts by our personal invitation (Romans 6:23, 10:9-10).

If you desire to receive Jesus Christ right now, follow these four steps:

1. Admit your need for forgiveness and peace.
2. Be willing to turn from your sins.
3. Believe that Jesus Christ died for you on the cross and rose from the grave.
4. Through prayer, invite Jesus Christ to come in and control your life.

Below is an example of what you can pray:

Dear Jesus, I believe that You died on the cross for my sins and that you arose from the grave. I know I have sinned and need forgiveness. I am willing to turn from my sins and receive you as Savior and Lord. Thank you for saving me. Amen.

How to Join Our Church
